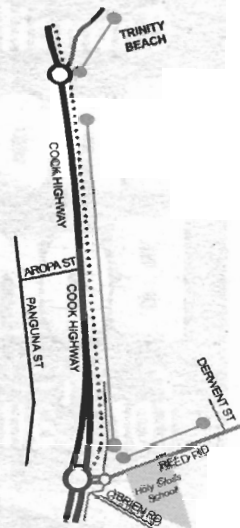
There have been requests to contact various individuals with expertise that may be able to help with the issues raised. Regrettably, there were five more wallabies killed last week; two females with joeys and a male.
